Under this agreement for 2017 Gympie East State School will receive

\$42 545*

This funding will be used to

- 85% of students to achieve C or better in English.
- 85% of students to achieve C or better in Maths.
- 90% of students to achieve to reach regional benchmarks for reading, maths and spelling.
- 40% of students achieving in the U2B's for NAPLAN- Yr 3 Reading, an increase from 33.5% in 2016.
- 33% of students achieving in the U2B's for NAPLAN- Yr 3 Numeracy, an increase from 29% in 2016.
- 40% of students achieving in the U2B's for NAPLAN- Yr 5 Reading, an increase from 33.3% in 2016.
- 50% of students achieving in the U2B's for NAPLAN- Yr 3 Numeracy, an increase from 42% in 2016.
- 100% of students to be above NMS for all strands assessed by NAPLAN.

Our initiatives include

- Provide effective and efficient financial support to enable sustained school improvement.
- Develop a best practice reading program that identifies students reading abilities and targets specific individual goals and areas of improvement.
- Create a quality assured curriculum and assessment plan with our Regional Small Schools Alliance

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employing teacher aides to implement a daily reading program which focuses on individual student's needs and directly targets the priority teaching area of reading.
- Employ a teacher to work with the Principal to oversee the school's improvement plan and work as a peer mentor.
- Purchase resources to embed the 'Spelling Mastery' program.
- Purchase resource to embed a balanced reading program.
- Provide Professional Develop to enhance reading program and curriculum and assessment plan.
