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Hello Gympie East parents, carers and community,

Students are settled into routines and classrooms are quiet, calm learning spaces which is absolutely fantastic to see. Our behaviour data is showing a decrease in playground behaviour from this time last year which we are obviously very happy to see. The new behaviour processes are working. Initially we saw a higher number of minor behaviours in the classroom, however, this is trending down with students understanding the expectations along with parents supporting the school's learning expectations.

Teachers are now confident with the new version 9 of the Australian Curriculum that we are operating with in English and Maths. In our Staff Meeting this week, teachers paired up and were discussing high impact strategies that they were implementing and how they differentiated for their students. These were great discussions to have and even better to see in practice.

At pick up time, students are to wait inside the gate until their parent's car pulls up in the stop and go area. We have had some students walking to cars in the line on the road, this cannot happen as it is dangerous.

PBL


Our focus for Week 3 is 'Wear a hat' while our focus for Week 4 is 'Build friendships'. Each week a PBL focus powerpoint is delivered in class with a lesson and a reminder for why this focus area is important.

NAPLAN

The National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) is a literacy and numeracy assessment that students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 sit each year. It is the only national assessment all Australian students have the opportunity to undertake.

Online NAPLAN tests provide precise results and are engaging for students. The tests are tailored (or adaptive), which means that each test presents questions that may be more or less difficult depending on a student's responses. This helps students remain engaged with the assessment. All Year 3 students will continue to complete the writing assessment on paper.

NAPLAN will run from $12 - 24^{th}$ March. Thank you to our fantastic P&C who will provide a breakfast for our students participating in NAPLAN.

Cross Country / Run Club


