- Increase A-B level results on report cards in English from 48% to 53%.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'A-C' in English from 85% to 92%.
- Increase achievement in key learning areas through the use of learning walls and deep understanding of the achievement standards.

Our initiatives include

- Empowering staff to deliver effective strategies for the teaching of reading and writing through the use of bump it up walls, learning walls, success criteria checklists, and analysis of draft writing with our HOC.
- Provide facilitated planning and data analysis for teachers (once per term).
- Fortnightly teacher meetings working on the CASW moderation project.
- Send teachers to other like schools to develop their practice and pedagogy.
- Pre and Post Moderation.
- Provide professional development, coaching and access to view best practices, to ensure staff development of their understanding and deconstruction of the Australian Curriculum.
- Increase teacher aide time to facilitate school based reading programs and extra support in literacy blocks.
- Professional development for teacher aides to effectively consolidate student learning of reading and writing.
